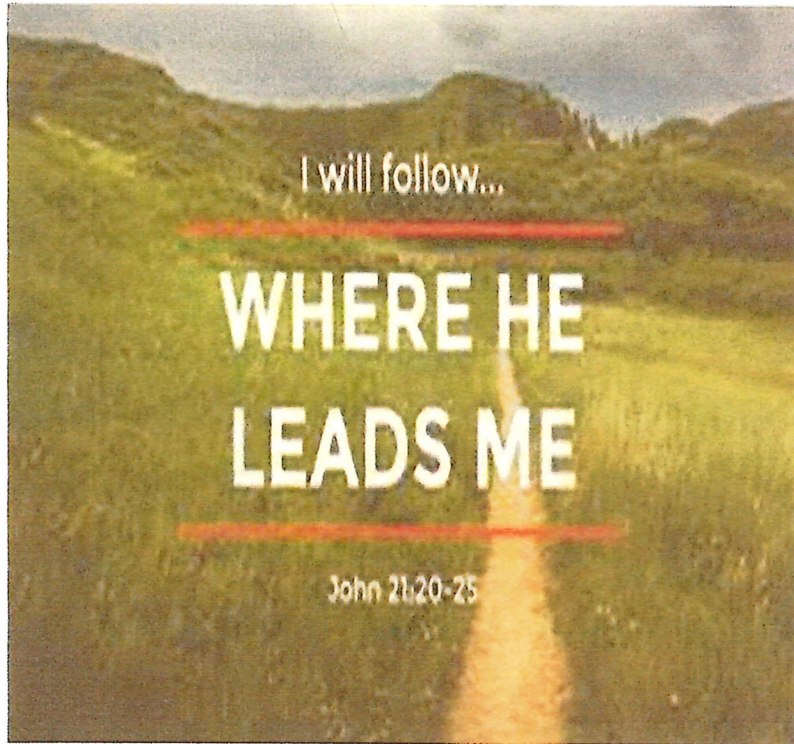

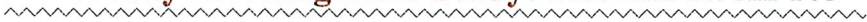

In the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who will judge the living and the dead, and in view of his appearing and his kingdom, I give you this charge: ² Preach the word; be prepared in season and out of season; correct, rebuke and encourage—with great patience and careful instruction. 2 Timothy 4: 1-2

Sunday, May 5

The Missions Team will host a discussion with missionaries and ministry partners right after service in the sanctuary. Join us as we hear news from some of the missionaries First Baptist supports. Lunch will be served immediately after the speakers.

- **Rick and Carol McArthur** – serving in Guatemala with Wycliffe Bible Translators. Rick and Carol continue to support the Vina ministry, which produces the faith-based children’s Deditos video series in many different languages.
- **Pastor Vitali Yuchkovski** – founder of Russian Missions out of Southampton, PA. Pastor Vitali is the founder of this ministry which provides humanitarian aid to at risk children, prison ministry, training for local pastors, and church planting. They have more recently been serving those displaced by the war in Ukraine.
- **Madelyn Sutton** – Director of Christian Caring Center, in Browns Mills, NJ. The CCC is an outreach to vulnerable residents of Burlington County. Accompanying Madelyn will be the new Development Coordinator, Randy Holston.
