

Pastor's Corner

Pastor's Corner: "Building up the Body of Christ" (October 26th, 2025)

In 1974, I started my TFE (Theological Field Education) at Wellesley Baptist Church, and I learned so many things there. I learned hospitality and I saw how people who were extremely rich could love the Lord as much as the poor did. During my TFE, I saw a church that was growing – the growing pains were real, but the growth was marvelous.

I met Dr. E. who was a licensed psychiatrist and an exorcist. He believed that both fields could exist together, and he practiced both. He studied to make sure that he gave the best counseling advice, but he was also aware that in the state of Massachusetts, witchcraft, sorcery, and satanism were real.

One evening Dr. E invited the youth of the church to spend the evening with his family, and I then found out that they had a huge garden and also an Olympicsized swimming pool. They had wealth but used what they had to build the body of Christ.

During one of the conversations that I had with Dr. E, he asked me what I needed. I told him honestly that I did not have enough money to pay for my tuition, and for the next three years he provided me with the amount that I needed. He always wore his tweed Harvard jackets in church on Sundays, but he was one of the most approachable people that I have ever met.

Because of our location, we had students from MIT, Wellesley, Babson College and other colleges and universities in the church. Dr. E knew that these students were smart, but he wanted them to not only prosper in their chosen fields, but to be able to stand strong in their faith and their commitment to God.

For the students to grow, the church had to be willing to grow. One of the most productive and the most painful activities was the arrival and then the eventual departure of the students after four years of being a part of the church. The entire church leadership poured themselves into the students, knowing that they would one day leave, but that they would forever remember their days being built up as part of the Body of Christ at Wellesley Baptist Church.
