

#### PASTOR'S CORNER

#### The Roll Call

Among the many ideas that the Reformers stood against during the 16<sup>th</sup> century were the interpretation of the Lord's Table as transubstantiation (as practiced by the Lutherans and Calvinists), believer's baptism versus infant baptism (as practiced by early Lutherans and Anabaptists), and lastly, taxation based on church records (as practiced by Catholics and Anglicans).

In a 1990 movie called *The Radicals* (which shares the origin story of the Anabaptists), the local vicar pressures the governor to receive taxes based on the number of people baptized as infants. His answer is that he cannot tax them because the Anabaptists do not baptize their infants.

In the development of denominations outside of the Catholic Church, one of the items that often remained was a certain fee given to the denomination based on local church membership. Thus, one can say that the Methodists and the Presbyterians are especially fastidious about keeping their membership up to date because they must pay yearly membership fees to their denominational head-quarters.

Fees and taxes aside, in the 19<sup>th</sup> century, the Baptists of New Jersey introduced the "Roll Call," which was an opportunity for members of a specific church or multiple churches in an association to come together. On a designated Sunday, all the Baptists would come together for worship and fellowship. They would call the names of all the members and the ones who could not physically attend

would send written greetings and an explanation of their absence.

As you can imagine the favorite song during these events was "When the Roll Is Called Up Yonder, I Will Be There" and biblical passages such as Hebrews 10:24-25, "And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching."

So, like our Baptist forefathers, we as the community of First Baptist Church of Mount Holly shall try to gather for a Roll Call on Sunday,

November 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2025, to see who we can count.
