

I need to testify to then goodness of **God!** Last month we had an enormous emergency in our Food Pantry, with our staff put on a pause without pay. We had no volunteers in place, just long lines of cars. BUT GOD! touched your hearts to pray, to come down and support by volunteering and donating. We were able to continue our pantry with reduced hours. Many came out to volunteer in extreme heat, and God gave a miracle of 99 more households with reduced hours- PTL!!!! Our 5 people are still without employment so please keep praying for them to find work. About 1/3 of our new volunteers are students who will be returning to school after August, so there is still room for you! Another unfortunate consequence will be limited opening hours of our food pantry, which will be 10am-12pm, Monday thru Friday. We are looking for immediate volunteers to serve in our Food Pantry. 
#### **A PRAYER WARRIORS NEEDED**



# Gideon's Army: Warriors of Provision

Generally, summer is a rough time for donations, but this year they have never been so critical. A Gideon Supporter is \$35 per month, some can give more and some can give less, but all are needed. A donation of \$25=4 boxes of food, \$35=6 boxes of food, \$50=8 boxes of food, \$75=12 boxes of food, \$100=12 boxes of food and 12 hot cooked meals. Once Gideon was convinced, he obeyed with zest, resourcefulness and speed. We would love to have you as part of our Gideon's Army of 300.











#### **EMERGENCY FOOD PROGRAM:**

The Christian Caring Center provided meals to 486 families or 1,667 individuals with 25,005 meals in July 2025.

#### **COMMUNITY LUNCH/RURAL HOMELESS PROGRAM:**

The Christian Caring Center served 926 hot cooked meals and continental breakfasts in July 2025. Additionally, we deliver 55 lunches and provide outreach to homeless, alcoholic, addicted, or mentally challenged individuals twice a week. We ask for your continued support for these individuals and our staff and volunteers.

#### **BACKPACK OUTREACH:**

Last year we were able to serve 169 children and some homeless with backpacks filled with school supplies-PTL!!! We believe the need will be even bigger this year. 
#### **SALVATION ARMY SERVICE UNIT & GRANTS:**

The Christian Caring Center serves as a volunteer service unit for the Salvation Army and three other grants.

- ·Assisted 2 households (4 individual) with rent in July 2025
- Assisted 3 households (6 individuals) with a security deposit in July 2025
- ·Provided 87 motel bed nights to 31 households (42 individuals) in July 2025
- ·Assisted 2 households (2 individuals) with utilities in July 2025

Our mom and 2 children in Edgewater Park are still with us for a few months more. We have selected another family who located housing in Camden and we are excited to connect her to her neighboring team. We are looking to establish another neighboring team in the Mt. Holly area. #### MEN'S EMERGENCY SHELTER PROGRAM: Jack Stelle Men's Emergency Shelter:

Currently, there are 2 men in the shelter. D.M. and V.C. D.M. has been hired at Oaks Integrated Mental Health Agency and possibly another non profit and joined a local church. He is also applying to affordable housing. V.C. is a senior and applying for affordable housing and working at the Christian Caring Center. We request your prayers for these men.

Holman House: We received another grant from Shelter Support Grant to complete more renovations like new windows, siding, wiring and dry wall. Can't wait.

Marion House: Our single father with 2 small children has been selected for his apartment and he and the children should be in their new apartment by the time you are reading this newsletter-PTL!!! Please pray for this family and the new one coming in-PRAYER WORKS!!!

#### Eden Village @ Christian Caring Center:
