Engage everyday moments in life to train your kids with spiritual truth.



During your morning routines:

Talk with your kids as you're waking them up, or at the breakfast table: "Good morning! Remember you can choose to be brave and trust God to help you do hard things this week, even when you don't think you can..."



While driving to or from school/activities:

Ask your kids as you're driving in the car: "What is this week's Big Answer?" Wait for them to say, "Bold faith trusts in God." Say this several times in different silly voices.



During a mealtime:

Ask your child: "If you were playing the ultimate game of hide and seek, where would you hide? (You can have them answer for different places like at church, at home, at grandma's house, etc.) Those are some great hiding spots. Rahab hid and protected the Israelite spies even when the king's men were looking for them. She chose to put her faith and trust in God and help His people!"



During bath time:

Consider playing your child's worship song this month "What an Awesome God," by Kid Kardia on YouTube. Encourage them to sing and praise Jesus! Remind them that when we worship Jesus, we can thank Him for loving us so much.



During special moments with your child:

Share with your child that even though we mess up and make mistakes or make the wrong choices, that doesn't make God love us any less. Rahab made a lot of wrong choices, but God still had an incredible plan for her – and He has an amazing plan for your life too (even when we mess up)! Wow!"



During your bedtime routine:

Pray with your child as you're going to bed, something like "Dear God, thank You for keeping Your promises to us. Help us to trust in Your plan even when we're scared. Give us courage to always to do the right thing..."
