Engage everyday moments in life to train your kids with spiritual truth.



During your morning routines:

Talk with your kids as you're waking them up, or at breakfast:
"What's something amazing you've seen?" Remind them that Jesus' face shone bright like the sun on the mountain. Jesus is more amazing than we know!



While driving to or from school/activities:

Ask: "What is this week's Big Answer?" Wait for: **"Jesus is amazing."**
Say it in silly voices. Then play "I Spy" and find one amazing thing God made outside your window.

During a mealtime:



Ask your child, "If you could have any superhero power for one day, what would you choose?" After everyone shares, say, **"Superhero powers are fun to imagine, but Jesus has real power! In our Bible story, Peter, James, and John saw Jesus shining bright and discovered that He was even more amazing than they knew. And there's always more for us to discover about Jesus too!"**

During bath time:



Consider playing your child's worship song this month "I've Got a Fire" by Kid Kardia, on YouTube. Encourage them to sing and praise Jesus! Remind them that worship is one way we can tell Jesus how amazing He is.

During special moments with your child:



Step outside together and look for something amazing God made - a sunset, clouds, trees, flowers, or stars. Remind your child that God's amazing creation can help us remember just how powerful and amazing Jesus is.

During your bedtime routine:



Pray with your child as you're going to bed: "Dear God, thank You for showing us how amazing Jesus is. Help us listen to Jesus and keep learning more about Him..."
