Engage everyday moments in life to train your kids with spiritual truth.



During your morning routines:

Talk with your kids as you're waking them up, or at breakfast:
"Good Morning! Remember that you are special to Jesus. He loves you so much!"



While driving to or from school/activities:

Ask your kids as you're driving in the car: "What is this week's Big Answer?" Wait for them to say, "I am special to Jesus." Say this several times in different silly voices.



During a mealtime:

Ask your child, "What is something special you would be sad to lose?" After everyone shares, say, "Jesus told a story about a woman who lost one special coin. She looked and looked until she found it, then she celebrated! Jesus says you are special to Him, like a special treasure."



During bath time:

Consider playing your child's worship song this month "I've Got a Fire" by Kid Kardia, on YouTube. Encourage them to sing and praise Jesus! Remind them that worship is one way we can tell Jesus how amazing He is.



During special moments with your child:

Share about a time you lost something important and how happy you were when you found it. Remind your child that Jesus loves them, looks for people who are far from Him, and celebrates when anyone chooses to love and follow Him.



During your bedtime routine:

Pray with your child as you're going to bed: "Dear God, thank You that I am special to Jesus. Help me remember that Jesus loves me and thinks that I am special..."
