Engage everyday moments in life to train your kids with spiritual truth.



During your morning routines:

Talk with your kids as you're waking them up, or at breakfast:

"Good morning! If you face a problem today, remember: nothing can stop God's plans. God is with you."



While driving to or from school/activities:

Ask your kids as you're driving in the car: "What is this week's Big Answer?" Wait for them to say, "God's power is bigger than any problem." Say it a few times in silly voices.



During a mealtime:

Ask your child: "If you had a secret mission, what would your mission be?" Then say: "Peter had an important mission too—telling people the good news about Jesus. Even prison couldn't stop God's plan for Peter to keep sharing about Jesus."



During bath time:

Consider playing your child's worship song this month "I've Got a Fire" by Kid Kardia, on YouTube. Encourage them to sing and praise Jesus! Remind them that worship is one way we can tell Jesus how amazing He is.



During special moments with your child:

Share with your child about a time God helped you through a hard problem, or a time someone prayed for you. Remind your child that God hears our prayers and helps us when we go to Him.



During your bedtime routine:

Pray with your child as you're going to bed: "Dear God, thank You that Your power is bigger than any problem. Help me to trust You and remember that nothing can stop Your plans."
