Engage everyday moments in life to train your kids with spiritual truth.



During your morning routines:

Talk with your kids as you're waking them up, or at the breakfast table: "What do you do to get ready for your day?" Explain that John had an important job: helping people get ready for Jesus. We can get our hearts ready too by praying, listening, and making space to know Jesus more.



While driving to or from school/activities:

Ask: "What is this week's Big Answer?" Wait for: "I can know Jesus more." Say it in silly voices. Then choose one simple way your family can make time for Jesus today.



During a mealtime:

Ask your child, "What's the craziest food you've ever eaten?" After they answer, tell them, "John the Baptist ate locusts and honey! John did some things differently, but God had a very special job for him—to help people get ready for Jesus."



During bath time:

Consider playing your child's worship song this month "I've Got a Fire" by Kid Kardia, on YouTube. Encourage them to sing and praise Jesus! Remind them that when we worship Jesus, we can thank Him for loving us so much.



During special moments with your child:

Help your child choose a Bible they like, listen to a Bible story, or ask someone to read with them. Remind them that every time they open God's Word, they can ask, "God, what do You want to show me about Jesus?"



During your bedtime routine:

Pray with your child as you're going to bed: "Dear God, thank You for loving us and giving us Your Word. Help us get our hearts ready to know Jesus more. Holy Spirit, help us listen and tell others about Jesus too..."
