EMEMBER THIS

SAY THIS

"Jesus came to save the world."

During this series our NewKidz will learn how the stories we read in The Bible connect to each other and teach us the Story of Jesus and His people.

Engage everyday moments in life to train your kids with spiritual truth.



During your morning routines:

Talk with your kids as you're waking them up, or at the breakfast table: "Good morning! You matter to Jesus and He thought you were worth giving His life for. Wow – that's the greatest kind of love ever!



While driving to or from school/activities:

Ask your kids as you're driving in the car: "What is this week's Big Answer?" Wait for them to say, "Jesus came to save the world." Say this several times in different silly voices.

During a mealtime:



Ask your child: "Have you ever taken the punishment for someone else? (They stole the cookies, but you said, "I'll pay the price, so they don't have too?") That's not something we usually do – but that's exactly what Jesus did for us, because He loves us. Jesus paid the price for our sin - He died so we could live..."

During bath time:



Consider playing your child's worship song this month "Won't Let Go," By Gateway Kids, on YouTube. Encourage them to sing and praise Jesus! Remind them that when we worship Jesus, we can thank Him for loving us so much.

During special moments with your child:



Share with your child how much you love them. Remind them that even though you love them so much, that Jesus loves them even more. He showed the ultimate example of love when He died for us on the cross- wow!"

During your bedtime routine:



Pray with your child as you're going to bed, something like "Dear God, thank you for sending Jesus to save us from sin. Even when things seem hard, help us to remember that You always have a good plan, just like You had a good plan to save the world. We love you..."
