Engage everyday moments in life to train your kids with spiritual truth.



During your morning routines:

Talk with your kids as you're waking them up, or at the breakfast table: "Good morning! Remember that God has great plans for your life. Even when you are not sure, you can always trust Him." While driving to or from school/activities:



Ask your kids as you're driving in the car: "What is this week's Big Answer?" Wait for them to say, "Jesus is coming back." Say this several times in different silly voices.

During a mealtime:



Ask your child: "Have you ever broken something that couldn't be fixed? (Toy, plate, trust with someone, etc.) There is a lot of brokenness in our world, and not just with things. The good news is that one day, Jesus is coming back to fix everything that's broken – families, hearts, the whole world – wow! He will make all things new and that's great news for us!"



During bath time:

Consider playing your child's worship song this month "Won't Let Go," By Gateway Kids, on YouTube. Encourage them to sing and praise Jesus! Remind them that when we worship Jesus, we can thank Him for loving us so much.



During special moments with your child:

Share with your child "Because we live in an imperfect and broken world, life isn't always what we plan or expect it to be. However, we can still live with hope everyday – knowing that God had good plans for us and Jesus is King forever..."



During your bedtime routine:

Pray with your child as you're going to bed, something like "Dear God, thank you for making a way so this life is not the end for us and for preparing an amazing home for your children in Heaven. Help us to trust You and Your plan always..."
