**SAY

"I can do good things for God."

During this series, our kids will learn about different people from The Bible and how they faced tough situations. Even in the middle of the battle, God was always there for them and He is there for us too!

Engage everyday moments in life to train your kids with spiritual truth.



During your morning routines:

Ask your kids as you're waking them up, or at the breakfast table:

"What is something you enjoy during your day? And what is something you don't like doing?" Wait for them to respond. **"Thank you for telling me that. There are things that I don't like to do either, but I remind myself to ask God for help to do tough things, and He can help you too."**



While driving to or from school/activities:

Ask your kids as you're driving in the car: "What is this week's Big Answer?" Wait for them to say, **"I can do good things for God."** Say this several times in different silly voices.



During a mealtime:

Ask your kids, "What is an emotion that you have an easy time showing? Hard time showing?" Tie this into our Bible story with something like, **"Sometimes we have emotions we experience that can be tough to face. But when we bring those to God, He can help us to keep doing good things."**



During bath time:

Consider playing your child's worship song this month "Nothing But The Blood" by Northview Kids, on YouTube. Encourage them to sing and praise Jesus! Remind them that when we worship Jesus, we can thank Him for loving us so much.



During special moments with your child:

Remind your child that when they are facing a tough situation, they can stop and ask God to help them. Even when it's tough to do, they can trust God through it all. Like our memory verse says, God has good plans for us!



During your bedtime routine:

Pray with your child as you're going to bed, something like "Thank You God for loving us so much. Thank You for being with us—even in tough situations. Help us to keep doing good things with You, even when it's hard to do."

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
