SAY THIS

"God created everything."

Engage everyday moments in life to train your kids with spiritual truth.



During your morning routines:

As you're waking up or eating breakfast, say: "Good morning! God made you on purpose and for a purpose. You are His favorite creation!"



While driving to or from school/activities:

Ask your kids as you're driving in the car: "What is this week's Big Answer?" Wait for them to say, "God created everything." Say this several times in different silly voices.



During a mealtime:

Ask your child: "If you could have any animal in the world as a pet, what would you choose and what would you name them?" After they answer, say, "God made so many amazing animals, and every one of them shows how creative, powerful, and wonderful He is."



During bath time:

Consider playing your child's worship song this month "Already Win" by Kids on the Move, on YouTube. Encourage them to sing and praise Jesus! Remind them that when we worship Jesus, we can thank Him for loving us so much.



During special moments with your child:

Ask your child about their favorite parts of God's creation, then share some of yours too—sunsets, the beach, monkeys, flowers, elephants, and more. Remind them, "The same God who made the stars and the moon and all the things you said knows your name and loves you so much."



During your bedtime routine:

Pray with your child as you're going to bed, something like "Dear God, thank You for making the whole world and for making me. Help me trust You, love You, and remember how big and good You are. Amen."
