Engage everyday moments in life to train your kids with spiritual truth.



During your morning routines:

As you're waking up or eating breakfast, say: "Good morning! Today let's remember who Jesus is – He is the Son of God and He loves you so much!"



While driving to or from school/activities:

Ask your kids as you're driving in the car: "What is this week's Big Answer?" Wait for them to say, "Jesus is the Son of God." Say this several times in different silly voices.



During a mealtime:

Ask your child: "If you could have one superpower for one day, what would you choose? Those would be some amazing and fun superpowers to have. Jesus doesn't just have power – He is the Son of God, Everything He did showed people who He really is!"



During bath time:

Consider playing your child's worship song this month "Already Won" by Kids on the Move, on YouTube. Encourage them to sing and praise Jesus! Remind them that when we worship Jesus, we can thank Him for loving us so much.



During special moments with your child:

Share with your child something like: "Jesus is God's Son and we can believe what He says, follow His example, and trust Him with our lives. He is not far away or made up. He is real, alive, and still at work today. He loves you so much..."



During your bedtime routine:

Pray with your child as you're going to bed, something like "Dear God, thank You for sending us Jesus and giving Him as an example that we can follow. Help us to obey His leading in our lives and to always trust Him..."
