# Engage everyday moments in life to train your kids with spiritual truth.



During your morning routines:

**As you're waking up or eating breakfast, say: "Good morning! Remember God chose you, He loves you, and He has good plans for your life!"**

While driving to or from school/activities:



**Ask your kids as you're driving in the car: "What is this week's Big Answer?" Wait for them to say, "I am chosen by God." Say this several times in different silly voices.**

During a mealtime:



**Ask your child: "What is something that you're waiting for? Maybe it's a birthday, a vacation, summer, or getting to do something special." Let them answer and then say something like: "David had to wait to become king, but he kept loving God and trusting Him while he waited. We can choose God while we have to wait too!"**

During bath time:



**Consider playing your child's worship song this month "Masterpiece," by Kid Kardia, on YouTube. Encourage them to sing and praise Jesus! Remind them that when we worship Jesus, we can thank Him for loving us so much.**

During special moments with your child:



**Ask your child: "What is one dream you have for the future?" Let them answer and then say: "God has good plans for you! While you wait, you can keep loving God, learning His Word, and becoming more like Him..."**

During your bedtime routine:



**Pray with your child as you're going to bed, something like: "Dear God, thank You for choosing us and loving us. Help us to remember that we don't have to be older to follow and obey You..."**
