Engage everyday moments in life to train your kids with spiritual truth.



During your morning routines:

As you're waking up or eating breakfast, say: "Good morning! God made us to love Him and love others. Keep your eyes open for someone you can show God's love to today..."

While driving to or from school/activities:

Ask your kids as you're driving in the car: "What is this week's Big Answer?" Wait for them to say, "God made me to love others." Say this several times in different silly voices.



During a mealtime:

Ask your child: "What is one way we can show love to someone this week?" Let them answer. Then come up with a practical way to do that this week. Some ideas would be writing a card to someone, praying for someone, helping an elderly neighbor, serving at church, etc." Loving people doesn't always have to be big or complicated. Sometimes love looks like noticing someone, including someone, helping someone, or simply being kind..."



During bath time:

Consider playing your child's worship song this month "Masterpiece," by Kid Kardia, on YouTube. Encourage them to sing and praise Jesus! Remind them that when we worship Jesus, we can thank Him for loving us so much.



During special moments with your child:

Share with your child about a time when someone helped you and it made a difference in your day or in your life. "When we help others, we are showing them God's love. He created us to love others..."



During your bedtime routine:

Pray with your child as you're going to bed, something like: "Dear God, thank You for loving us so much. Help us to love You and follow You always and to have a heart to love others, just like Jesus..."



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
