Engage everyday moments in life to train your kids with spiritual truth.



During your morning routines:

Talk with your kids as you're waking them up, or at the breakfast table: "Good morning! Jesus loves you so much. Let's start our morning off by reminding Him how much we love Him too!"

While driving to or from school/activities:



Ask your kids as you're driving in the car: "What is this week's Big Answer?" Wait for them to say, "We worship Jesus who loves us." Say this several times in different silly voices.

During a mealtime:



Ask your child: "If you could give a gift to someone special to you (and cost wasn't an issue, meaning it could be anything), who would you give it to and what would you give them? That sounds amazing. The lady in our Bible story this week gave Jesus the best gift she could offer Him, because she wanted Jesus to know how much she loved Him. She worshipped Jesus by pouring the expensive perfume on His feet to show her love for Him – wow!"

During bath time:



Consider playing your child's worship song this month "So So Good," By Kid Kardia, on YouTube. Encourage them to sing and praise Jesus! Remind them that when we worship Jesus, we can thank Him for loving us so much.

During special moments with your child:



Share with your "Isn't it amazing that no matter what we've done that when we come to Jesus and ask for forgiveness, He is just and quick to forgive us? Just like the lady in our Bible story poured out her perfume and Jesus forgave her, Jesus pours out His love for us every day and forgives us when we ask too."

During your bedtime routine:



Pray with your child as you're going to bed, something like "Dear God, thank you for loving us so much and forgiving us. Help us to worship you always with the things that we think, say and do..."
