Engage everyday moments in life to train your kids with spiritual truth.



During your morning routines:

Remind your kids as you're waking them, or at the breakfast table: "Let's choose to worship God today no matter how we feel! When we're sad we can worship Him. When we're happy, we can worship Him. When we're angry we can worship Him. God is so good and worth worshipping all the time!"



While driving to or from school/activities:

Ask your child what this week's "Big Answer" is and wait for them to say, "I can worship God." Repeat this several times in different silly voices.



During a mealtime:

Ask your child "Who are some of your favorite singers/bands and songs? Thinking about our favorite singers, bands, and songs, reminds me of how we can worship God through music. Worship means to show God that we love Him with all our heart. When we worship God through music, it does just that - we remind Him that we love Him!"



During bath time:

Consider playing your child's worship song this month "Your Love for Me," on YouTube. Encourage them to sing and praise Jesus! Remind them that when we worship Jesus, we can thank Him for loving us so much.



During special moments with your child:

Remind your child "God will always be there for us and He promises to love us no matter what happens. Let's shout out 'We love you Jesus' on the count of three. 1...2...3... 'We love you Jesus!'"



During your bedtime routine:

Pray something like "Thank you God for creating us and being so good to us. Help us to worship You always, no matter how we feel..."
