Engage everyday moments in life to train your kids with spiritual truth.

During your morning routines:



Ask your kids as you're waking them up, or at the breakfast table: "What is a hard choice that you have had to make?" Wait for them to respond. "When we face tough situations, God is always there to help us. God wants to take care of you and help you make the right choice. He can help us make choices, that honor Him, even when it's hard to do."

While driving to or from school/activities:



Ask your kids as you're driving in the car: "What is this weeks Big Answer?" Wait for them to say, "I can make the right choice." Say this several times in different silly voices.

During a mealtime:



Ask your child "What is a choice you made today that you are proud of?" "It can be difficult to make the right choice sometimes, but God has a good plan for us (Jer. 29:11). Just like in our Bible Story this week – We saw that God had a good plan to protect His people, and God has a good plan for you too. We need to trust Him."

During bath time:



Consider playing your child's worship song this month "Wake" by Hillsong Young and Free, on YouTube. Encourage them to sing and praise Jesus! Remind them that when we worship Jesus, we can thank Him for loving us so much.

During special moments with your child:



Engage in a fun game of "hot and cold" with your child. Take turns hiding an item. The other person must try to find it through listening to the hider give them hints of how close they are by saying "hot" or "cold". Explain how when we listen to Gods voice, we are able to make better decisions that direct us to His plan for our lives!

During your bedtime routine:



Pray with your child as you're going to bed, something like "Thank You God for being faithful and having a good plan for us. Help us to make the right choice in tough situations...."
