Asking God for the Impossible!

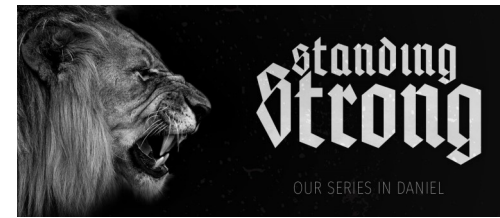
Read Daniel 2:1-24

Go around and have everyone share the biggest thing they have ever asked of God. Did God answer it?

Take a look at how Daniel handled the impossible task that the king had asked of him. What are some practical things we can learn from his example?

- Daniel's friends
- Daniel's strategy
- Daniel's response



## Activity:

Where to find wisdom?

Where did King Nebuchadnezzar seek wisdom?

Where did Daniel seek wisdom?

Write one scripture address and one letter of the phrase "God gives wisdom" on 7 slips of paper. Hide them around the room:

- James 1:5
- Proverbs 2:6
- 1 Kings 4:29
- Isaiah 50:4
- 2 Timothy 3:15
- Ephesians 1:17
- Proverbs 8:11

You can choose to read scriptures as the family finds them or once they are all found. When the family has found all the passages and unscrambles the message, ask:  
What did we learn about wisdom from the Bible?

True wisdom comes from God, and God passes that wisdom on to us in many ways. Have each person in your family tell the wisest advice he or she has ever received. Now have everyone share their favorite advice from the Bible.
