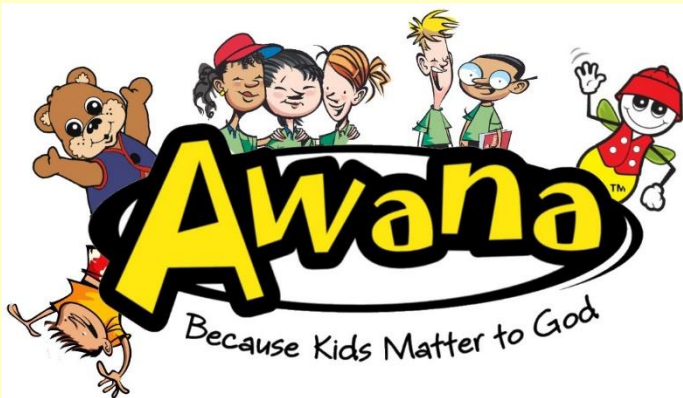

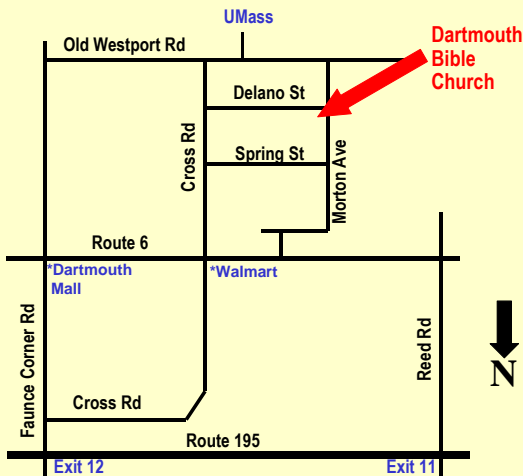

Sparks® ignites kids' curiosity to seek the truths of Scripture, laying a foundation of wisdom for knowing Christ.

Game Time: Fun and fast group games!

Bible Lesson: Continuing a biblical foundation through songs, crafts, Bible stories and games; Sparks learn the importance of God's word and the love Jesus has for us.

Handbook and Awards: Sparks work through three handbooks (one per year) reciting verses learned at home. Leaders will work 1-on-1 with kids to nurture their understanding of biblical truth.

T&T engages clubbers by answering their spiritual questions, guiding them through this pivotal life stage to grow in God's grace.

Handbook Time: Clubbers pass sections in four handbooks (one per year) in their small groups. It is best if verses and sections are completed at home ahead of club night.
