

A Note From Pastor Lauren

Happy Easter! Yes, it is *still* appropriate to wish each other "Happy Easter" because Easter is not just a day, but a whole season in the church year. This is maybe even more important this year since Easter Sunday arrived so early on March 31st.

When it comes to upcoming worship services, we will see that April 7th is the Second Sunday of Easter, April 14th is the Third Sunday of Easter, April 21st is the Fourth Sunday of Easter, and so on until we arrive at Pentecost Sunday (May 19th this year). There are seven Sundays of Easter in this liturgical year. Hooray! Alleluia! Happy Easter!

Professor of Preaching and Worship Lawrence Hull Stookey reminds us, "The recovery of Easter as 'the Great Fifty Days' of the year can move the church along toward a fuller understanding of what the resurrection of the Lord implies. Easter is not one closing day at the end of a lengthy period of Lent. Easter is one extended rejoicing in the resurrection

that more than exceeds in length the Lenten disciplines. The first day of the season, Easter Day, is the opening of a protracted celebration, even as the Resurrection is itself the opening to a vast new reality." (Lawrence Hull Stookey, *Calendar: Christ's Time for the Church*, pg. 56)

The Lenten days of prayer, fasting, and discipline can be a lot to take by the time we get to Holy Week. It is a necessary and important time, though it can feel heavy. Easter Sunday ushers in a whole new feeling and a whole new season. This is now a time for celebration. Eastertide is an extended rejoicing in the miracle of resurrection and new life, ushering in a new reality. Let us rejoice and be glad for weeks to come, for Christ is indeed Risen. Hooray! Alleluia! Happy Easter!
