#### A Note From Pastor Lauren

This year, the Season of Lent begins on February 14th (also Valentine's Day). I will once again offer Ashes to Go in front of the church from 7 - 9 AM and our Discipleship Class will help lead the Ash Wednesday Service at 7 PM in our sanctuary. Ash Wednesday falling on Valentine's Day has happened once before during my ministry at CFC, and it does (admittedly) feel a bit odd.

For those Christians who observe the Season of Lent, which obviously begins on Ash Wednesday, this is a day that we intentionally set aside. We are reminded that life is finite and precious. We have ashes imposed on us with the tender words, "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return."

I often remember the loving words of minister and artist Rev. Jan Richardson who reflected on Ash Wednesday in her poem "Blessing the Dust." Richardson wrote, "So let us be marked not for sorrow. And let us be marked not for shame. Let us be

marked not for false humility or for thinking we are less than we are but for claiming what God can do within the dust, within the dirt, within the stuff of which the world is made, and the stars that blaze in our bones, and the galaxies that spiral inside the smudge we bear."

Yes, this act of remembering that we are dust is *also* about affirming that God can do a whole lot within the dust and the dirt and the stuff of which the world is made. It need not be a day where we are marked for sorrow and shame so much as a day for remembering that stars blaze in our bones and galaxies spiral inside the smudge we bear. We are part of God's good creation, after all. Maybe it's not such a bad thing to remember on a day where we can also give thanks to God for love in many forms.
