The Apostles' Creed

Session #2

For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved (Romans 10:10) God's people share their faith in Christ Jesus with others. We share our faith in many non-verbal ways: loving our neighbors, serving our community, and spreading God's love to all. We also share our faith in many verbal ways: telling others about Jesus, proclaiming his love, and confessing our Christian faith. Confessing the Apostles' Creed is a way for us to share our faith and live out our new life in Christ.
