Read Mark 2:13-17

- 1. What thoughts do you have about Jesus' invitation to Levi to "follow him"?
- 2. To follow Jesus, Levi had to leave his work as a tax collector and the life that afforded him. Does following Jesus always have a cost associated with it for each person? If so, what is that cost?
- 3. If you have accepted the invitation to follow Jesus, what have you had to leave behind? Was Jesus worth it?
- 4. Why was Jesus eating with tax collectors and sinners? How do you see that translating into today for you as one of his disciples?
- 5. What is Jesus calling sinners to? Why not the righteous?
- 6. The invitation to follow Jesus is for anyone and everyone. How do you desire this to shape how you pray or how you engage with other people?
- 7. How do you feel led to respond after reflecting on this passage?
