DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Read Mark 6:1-6

1. In Mark 6:2–3, the people are “amazed” yet offended. Where do you see yourself reacting emotionally to Jesus without submitting to Him?
2. Mark 6:5–6 says Jesus “could not do many miracles there” because of their lack of faith. What does this reveal about how faith affects our access to what God wants to do?
3. Where might you be keeping one hand on the wheel instead of trusting Jesus?
4. What does Mark mean when he says the people of Nazareth were “amazed” yet still took offense at Jesus?
5. How should we interpret Mark 6:5-6, where “Jesus could not do any miracles there” because of their lack of faith?
6. What words, reactions, or questions does Mark repeat to describe the people’s response to Jesus in Mark 6:2-3
7. Can you name a place where you felt spiritually inspired, but nothing changed afterwards?
