1. What details jump out to you about how Jesus calls the fisherman? What is unique about how he calls them?
2. When you read about the fisherman leaving their nets what stood out to you the most? The speed or the trust?
3. In Brad's fishing story and the passage who is the one taking the initiative the student or the teacher?
4. Why do you think Jesus chose ordinary fisherman instead of the "religious all-stars" of the day?
5. What does it tell us about discipleship that Jesus says "I will make you fishers of men" instead of "Go figure it out yourself".

6. How does the idea of apprenticeship (watch, learn, imitate, do) help us better understand what following Jesus is all about.

7. If following Jesus disrupts our normal life, what are you holding on to that is keeping you from being disrupted?

8. Who in your life could you apprentice and disciple?

9. If Jesus came to you during your normal routine, like he did the fisherman, what would it look like for you to say Yes right there?
