Accepting applications for

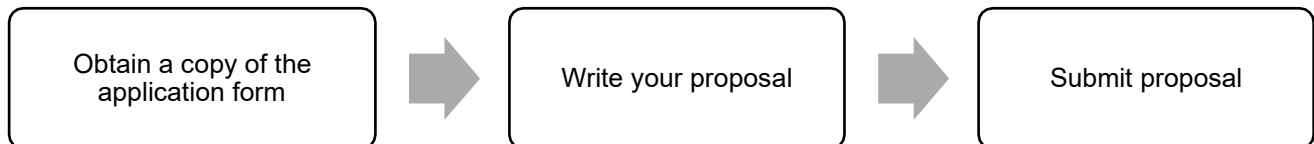
- Creating new ministries or programs
