Mark Rushworth - THE BATTLE FOR BELIEF (Mark 9:14-29)

- 1.** Did anything from Sunday (either from worship, contributions, the sermon) that stood out to you as especially impacting, interesting, or difficult to understand?
- 2.** I'm sure Peter would have rather stayed on the mountaintop with his tent beholding Jesus' glory than to have descended into the mire and misery of sin. In what ways are you tempted to build your tent and separate from the pain and suffering of the world? How do you overcome this tendency in order to be Christ's witnesses and make disciples?
- 3.** How can the father have both faith and unbelief at the same time? How can you have both at the same time?
- 4.** What does this cry ("Lord help my unbelief") tell you about the nature of faith? About believers' exercising of faith?
- 5.** On Sunday Mark said, "those who depend more, pray more". Do you agree? Why or why not? Do you see your life as a life of depending on God? Does your prayer life reflect this? How might you see more of your dependence in order to increase your prayer life?
