

## CityChurch Building Reopening Phase One

**With a strong desire to both protect God's people and our neighbors from further spread of COVID-19 while also recognizing the God designed need for community and gathering, the staff and elders of CityChurch present the following Reopening Plan. We expect to reopen in at least three and possibly three phases, with phase two beginning July 26, phase three beginning when school starts and phase four being whenever that wonderful day comes when COVID-19 precautions are no longer necessary. Phase One is outlined below.**

**Timing:** Sunday June 21 until July 19 (five Sundays)

**Auditorium/Services:** 50% seating capacity.

Alternate rows (rows that are open at the 9:15am service will be closed for the 11am and vice versa)  
Masks are strongly recommended at all times but will be required for singing - as such we ask that everyone brings a mask but some masks will be available for those who do not bring one.  
Service will be no longer than one hour long to give greater turnaround time for extra cleaning.

**First Impressions:** New cleaning procedures.

Hand sanitizer provided by hosts at the door until permanent touchless sanitizer stations arrive.

**KidCity:** No KidCity until schools reopen (Phase Three).

Classroom doors will be locked and no one allowed in except for a nursing mother's room.

**Overflow:** The Fellowship Hall available as overflow area/area for families with kids.

**Cleaning:** Bathroom surfaces wiped down every 30 minutes including but not limited to:  
Doorknobs and handles, Toilet handles and toilet seats, toilet paper and paper towel dispensers, sinks and sink knobs and anything else that gets frequently touched.

**Livestream:** Our Livestream will continue to be available on Facebook and Youtube for those in high risk groups and others who are not comfortable regathering yet and those who are sick, symptomatic, running a fever, etc.
