## BIBLE STORY FOCUS

God's plan is perfect.  
Moses in the Basket  
• Exodus 1:21-2:10

**WHAT YOU NEED:** Paperclip "Memory Verse Card" (from the Week One Activity Pages on the Website) in your Bible at Proverbs 3:5. You will also need a CD player and this month's worship song, "God's Way Is Perfect," which you will need to download from the Website. You will also need a Bible.

**LEADER:** "Hello, friends! It's so good to see you! I'm super excited because this month we're going on a great adventure! This WHOLE month we're going to be hearing about a man named Moses. He went on a really great adventure. And, while we hear all about Moses, we're going to be learning that **God's way is perfect!** Whoop! I'm so excited. And, when I ask you this very important question, 'Whose way is perfect?' you say, '**God's way is perfect!**' Let's try it. **Whose way is perfect?**"

**CHILDREN AND LEADER: "God's way is perfect!"**

**LEADER:** "Great job! You guys are awesome! Let's sing our new song!"

Lead children in singing "God's Way Is Perfect," this month's worship song.

"What incredible singers you are! This is going to be a fantastic month! **Whose way is perfect?**"

**CHILDREN AND LEADER: "God's way is perfect!"**

**LEADER:** "That's right! **God's way is perfect!** In fact, our Memory Verse says just that. Watch me say it and do the motions, and then you can do it with me. 'God's way (point both hands up) is perfect' (two thumbs up), 2 Samuel 22:31. (Open your hands like a book.) Let's try that together."

**CHILDREN AND LEADER: "'God's way (point both hands up) is perfect' (two thumbs up), 2 Samuel 22:31." (Open your hands like a book.) (Repeat several times.)**

**LEADER:** "Great job, everyone! Are you ready to hear a story from the Bible? (Hold up Bible and pause.) You are? Fantastic! Today's story is about the beginning of a great adventure with a BABY!

"Well, the baby in today's story was named Moses, and his mother loved him very, very much. But little did they know that God had a great adventure planned for Moses. And it started at the very beginning with a mean king named Pharaoh! Let's give him a thumbs down. (Demonstrate.) Can you guys do that with me too? (Demonstrate.) Good job. Now remember, Pharaoh was not a nice king. (Thumbs down.)



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Pharaoh didn't want any boy babies to grow up and become king, so he ordered that they all be taken away. Yikes!

"Well, Moses' mom was not having that, and she wanted to protect her baby, so she put him in a basket and then put him in the river near the tall plants so that nobody could see him. Then she asked Moses' sister to stay and watch out for him.

"Let's get our pretend binoculars to see if we can keep a watch out for baby Moses too. Do you guys have your pretend binoculars out? (*Demonstrate.*) Fantastic! Okay, let's look. (*Hold up pretend binoculars.*) I see Moses' sister. Hi! (*Wave.*) Oh, wait ... and there's the basket. And there's baby Moses still hanging out in the basket. He looks safe to me! You guys see him? (*Pause.*) Okay, good. You tell me if you see anyone coming to help the baby. (*Pause.*) Is that ...? Oh ... (*laugh*) no, that's just a little frog in the river. Okay, keep watching.

"Do you see someone? Wait, there comes someone! But we can't see who it is! Do you think it's a firefighter? Or a doctor? (*Gasp.*) No, it's a princess! You guys, it's THE princess—the Pharaoh's daughter! Uh-oh, she sees the baby in the basket. (*Pause.*) She is! She IS going to help! The princess felt bad that the baby was crying and all alone. She wanted to take really good care of him, but she needed help to do that. So Moses' sister popped up. She said she knew someone who could help with the baby! It was Moses' mother! 'Perfect!' declared the princess, 'Come along with me.'

"That's quite a lot of adventure for a little baby, isn't it? But God was just getting started. He had a big plan for Moses and like you saw today, God's plan is perfect! Baby Moses could have been taken away by the mean Pharaoh, but instead he was rescued by a princess and still got to be with his mom. Perfect, I say! Just perfect!

**Whose way is perfect? God's way is perfect!**

"So when I ask you: '**Whose way is perfect?**' (*Hand to ear.*) You guys are going to yell out, '**God's way is perfect!**' Ready? **Whose way is perfect?**"

**CHILDREN AND LEADER: "God's way is perfect!"**

**LEADER: "Great job! Let's say it one more time. Whose way is perfect?"**

**CHILDREN AND LEADER: "God's way is perfect!"**

**LEADER: "That's right, friends. No matter what, God's plans are always perfect. Let's pray.**

"Dear God, thank You for having plans for each one of our lives and thank You for always making them perfect. We love You, God. Amen."
