



MAKE IT TRUE - RUG

After children have participated in Make It Fun, gather them on a rug or in the corner of a room for a large group time that includes worship and Bible Story.

Use the full mix of the monthly song provided with the curriculum to lead your preschoolers in worship and then settle them for the memory verse and Bible story.

Choose an engaging adult to tell the Bible story. This person should be able to command the attention of preschoolers and control the group through animated storytelling. These scripts are written to be "told" and not "read." Advanced preparation is necessary.

BIBLE STORY FOCUS

God can tell me the right way.
Moses and the Burning Bush
• Exodus 3

WHAT YOU NEED: Paperclip "Memory Verse Card" (from the Week One Activity Pages on the Website) in your Bible at Proverbs 3:5. You will also need a CD player and this month's worship song, "God's Way Is Perfect," which you will need to download from the Website. You will also need a Bible.

LEADER: "Good morning, everyone! It's so good to see you today. I can't wait to sing with you today. I can't wait to hear more of Moses' great adventure today. But what do you think we're going to do first? (Pause.) You're right! We're going to sing our song. I can't wait! Before we do, remind me: **Whose way is perfect?**"

CHILDREN AND LEADER: "God's way is perfect!"

LEADER: "Yes, that's right!

Lead children in singing "God's Way Is Perfect," this month's worship song.

"Yay! What incredible singers you are. **Whose way is perfect?**"

CHILDREN AND LEADER: "God's way is perfect!"

LEADER: "That's right! **God's way is perfect!** Remember, our Memory Verse this month tells us that. Are you ready? (Pause.) Let's do it! 'God's way (point both hands up) is perfect' (two thumbs up), 2 Samuel 22:31. (Open your hands like a book.) Let's try that together."

CHILDREN AND LEADER: "'God's way (point both hands up) is perfect' (two thumbs up), 2 Samuel 22:31." (Open your hands like a book.) (Repeat several times.)

LEADER: "That is awesome. I have another amazing adventure story about Moses from the Bible. (Hold up Bible.) This story and all the other stories in this book are true and preeetty amazing! Are you all ready to get started? (Pause.) Are you?! (Pause.) Okay, let's get started! Like I said, today's story is about Moses, but he's not a baby in this story. He's all grown up and his job is taking care of a herd of sheep on a mountain. Everyone say, 'Baaaaaa!' (Pause.) Good job!

"So, while Moses was watching his sheep, something amazing happened. There was a bush off in the distance. But friends, you will never believe what happens next. The bush in this story caught on fire! Everybody say, 'Whoooa!' (Pause.) Yes, the bush was on fire! On a mountain! With no one else around. But the even more amazing part was that the bush wasn't burning up. You know how when you put wood into a fire, the wood burns up? That's how the fire burns. Well, I told you this story was amazing!



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Moses and the Burning Bush
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The bush wasn't burning up AT ALL!

"So, we have a bush that catches on fire but isn't burning up, and Moses is standing there watching all of this happen. What else could Moses do but go and have a closer look at it?!

"When he got closer, he heard a voice from inside the bush. It was God! You guys, God was talking from a bush! Isn't that amazing?! God said 'Moses. Moses.'

"Moses said back to God, 'Here I am.' Then God told Moses that he had a great adventure planned for him and that Moses was going to help rescue God's people from the mean king Pharaoh.

"'Me?' Moses said. 'I don't think you want ME, Lord. I don't know what to do or the right way to go.'

"But God said he would tell Moses the right way. God said He had a perfect plan, and if Moses and God could work together, it was going to be a great adventure!

"Now, you guys tell me, what do you think Moses said after that? (*Pause.*) Do you think he went on the great adventure with God? (*Pause.*) Yep, he did! Because he knew God's way is perfect. It's perfect, I tell you, perfect! **Whose way is perfect? God's way is perfect!**

"So I'm going to ask you: '**Whose way is perfect?**' (*Hand to ear.*) And you guys are going to yell out, '**God's way is perfect!**' Ready? Okay, **Whose way is perfect?**"

CHILDREN AND LEADER: "God's way is perfect!"

LEADER: "Great job! Let's say it again. **Whose way is perfect?**"

CHILDREN AND LEADER: "God's way is perfect!"

LEADER: "That's right, friends. No matter what, God's plans are always perfect. Let's pray together.

"Dear God, thank You for having plans for each one of our lives, and thank You for always making them perfect. We love You, God. Amen."
