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# Hey Parents!

Today, our Bottom Line was, “Be kind to others because God is kind to you.”

The cotton balls in your child’s Kindness Bucket represent the ways God has shown us kindness. The pieces of paper in the plastic bag contain various ideas your child came up with in order to be kind to someone throughout the week.

Our challenge to kids is to fill up the bucket with their own kindnesses, just as God has been kind to us!

Here’s how that can happen. As kids complete an act of kindness from their bag, they will take out the corresponding Kindness Card. Then crumple up the card and replace a cotton ball in their cup with the crumpled card. (You can either keep the cotton balls or throw them away.)

Encourage kids throughout your week to complete all of their ideas to be kind. Make it fun by having more paper ready for them to think of additional ideas they can fill their cups with.
