PERSONAL PRAYER GUIDE

God wants to change people's lives through you and through me. What a humbling thought. We are not worthy. We have done nothing to be worthy. This thought should bring us before God on our knees. We must be clean when we approach the throne of God in prayer. Spend time in prayer and meditation as you think about the way you live your daily life.

Known Sins
