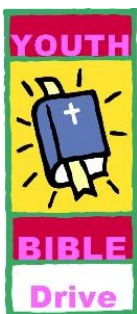

COLLEGE MISSION TRIP

Christmas day was obviously different for the team of 9 university students, including 6 members from FBC, who spent their semester break sharing the true meaning of Christmas in a country with limited access to the good news of Christ. We did not gather with family to open presents. We did not eat turkey, dressing, and all the desserts. We did not make snow angels and snow men. Yet, for those on the trip, the experience far outweighed anything missed because what happened on Christmas day on the other side of the world had eternal significance. I hope you had the opportunity to share the true meaning of Christmas with someone this season. For us, it was a daily activity, especially on December 25. On that day, we gave gifts to our students, but more importantly we shared the great gift God has given in his Son. We taught the Christmas carols, "Joy to the World" and "Away in a Manger" and the meaning behind their words. We acted out a skit emphasizing the true meaning of Christmas in front of several hundred students. We shared the Christmas story and the good news of Jesus, even seeing some students respond in faith. One student called these experiences, "the way Christmas should be."

We want to say "Thank you" to our church family for supporting us on this incredible opportunity. E. M. Bounds said, "Prayer is our most formidable weapon, the thing which makes all else we do efficient." Laveta Sergeant told me the same thing just before we left when she said, "Prayer is the work." Your prayer support was not an addition to our work, it was the work. It made every opportunity we had a chance for eternal change. You were faithful to pray and our students were faithful to share the message. It was a partnership in the gospel and one that can continue. Much of our work was sharing with students who still have yet to believe in Christ. We continue to pray for these students, and ask you to do the same. Over the next few weeks let me encourage you to ask Andrew Eaton, Steven Doss, James Forbis, Josh Mauldin, or Lee and Kacie Woodmansee about a student they met on the trip for whom you can continue to pray that they would embrace the gospel. We would be glad to share.
