"Judah" Mission Trip Report

We could literally fill up the Voice with stories from our recent trip to our partner city of "Judah." It was an incredible experience that is difficult to sum up in just a few words. But as I think back over the whole experience and everything leading up to it, the word that comes to mind is faithful.

You, our church family, were faithful. You were faithful to give generously and sacrificially so that we could take the gospel to those who had not heard. You were faithful to pray that those who heard would respond. You were faithful to pray that God would keep us safe and healthy. Your faithful support was necessary and we are thankful for it.

Our students were faithful. They were faithful to prepare for ministry for months leading up to the trip. They were faithful to pray before and during our trip for those they would meet. While in Judah, they were faithful in demonstrating Christ-like character and love to each other, to fellow believers, and to the lost. Most importantly, they were faithful to share the gospel. They took advantage of every opportunity to engage others in conversation about Jesus-including 13 evangelistic small group meetings and 5 house church meetings, all in 5 days. Students shared their testimonies, they shared gospel tracts, they shared the Christmas story, the answered questions about faith and the Bible, they did whatever it took to help others understand the good news of Jesus Christ. Our students prepared to share the gospel, traveled around the world to do so, and at every chance they did just that. They were faithful to the mission God gave them.

God was faithful. We asked God to keep us safe, he did. We asked God to give us opportunities to share his message, he did. We asked him to use us, he did. We asked him to help people respond to the gospel in faith, he did. No matter what we shared, we did not have the power to change a single life, to make one person believe the gospel; however, we asked God to make himself known and change lives for eternity, and he did. He was faithful to do what we could never do as 30 people expressed a desire to receive Christ as savior and follow him as Lord. He brought life to new believers, he brought encouragement to brothers and sisters in Christ, and he blessed us. He was and forever is faithful whether in Arkansas or around the world.
