God calls us to serve Him boldly and faithfully, growing in grace and truth, as we reach each person in our community and engage unreached people groups around the world with the gospel of Jesus Christ. This new year holds great promise and opportunity as we seek the Lord and follow Him. What opportunities await us this year?

This Sunday, January 17, our church family will vote on the motion recommended by our Phase II Committee to remodel the North Building (formerly the Goff-McNair Building), including connecting the buildings on the east end of the current alleyway, in order to provide additional space for children, Middle School students, youth, college students, and adults. We have discussed the recommendation, the cost, and the benefits for several weeks and months. Sunday morning we will set the course for where we believe God is leading us.

Also, this Sunday morning my sermon will help us know what the Bible teaches about the value of life so we will decide to treat all people with the value and dignity that God does. Each person, from the moment of conception until the final breath, is precious in the sight of God. As Christ followers, our belief in life needs to become a conviction and core principle. We will stand against abortion, against pornography, against child and spouse abuse, against anything that devalues life. And we will stand for life, for people struggling with shame, for people facing difficult decisions, for people fighting addictions, for God's love and compassion to be demonstrated to all people.

This Spring, I invite each person to be involved in a mission or ministry project. During Spring Break, our youth will be returning to Mission Arlington to take the gospel to children and families often overlooked by society. Our college students will be traveling to New Orleans for Mission Lab as they use construction teams and other service venues to share Christ. Here in Fayetteville we will be praying for specific neighborhoods and families one Saturday and, on the following Saturday, giving them a gospel witness with an invitation to join us Easter Sunday. Everyone can be involved somewhere.

During 2010, how will you serve God and take the good news of Jesus Christ to those who need to hear? The opportunities await us; let us be faithful.

The topics of study for the church history course are:






