One of the great blessings of First Baptist Church is the Wednesday evening ministries. It is a time of enrichment as we gather with a large number of our church family to enjoy a much broader experience of Christian growth and fulfillment.

If you are new to the church or have not attended on Wednesday evenings recently, you will be pleasantly surprised by all of the activity and by how many people attend. There is something for everyone. Consider the ministries taking place

We invest in Bible study because God's Word equips us for every good work.

On top of all of these benefits, we find our lives enriched by the friendships that grow out of the Christian fellowship on Wednesday nights. Mingled all through the activities are conversations, encouragements, and laughter. God's people strengthen one another.

Whether you can come for all of the activities on Wednesday evenings or take part in only a few, make this night a priority for your family. You will find yourself enriched now and for years to come.
