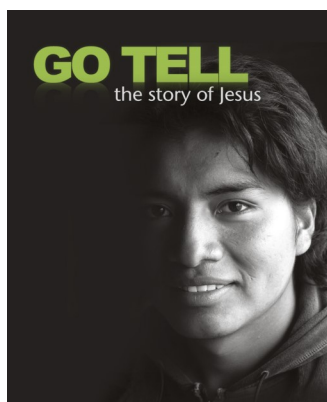

One of the great blessings of First Baptist Church is the Wednesday evening ministries. It is a time of enrichment as we gather with a large number of our church family to enjoy a much broader experience of Christian growth and fulfillment.

If you are new to the church or have not attended on Wednesday evenings recently, you will be pleasantly surprised by all of the activity and by how many people attend. There is something for everyone. Consider the ministries taking place on a typical Wednesday evening: missions experience and education for older pre-schoolers up to high school girls, music training for every age, prayer groups for youth and for adults, Bible study groups for youth, college, and adults, and nursery provided during all of this. Each of these activities enriches our worship, our spiritual growth, and our Christian service.

Begin all of these activities with a family meal being served at 5:00 p.m. with a salad, baked potato, meat and vegetables, dessert, and choice of beverages, plus a kid-friendly selection. This meal is planned and prepared by our church hostess with a loving team of volunteers. In the midst of a hectic week, we come together for a meal where we can sit and talk, laugh and share.

All of these activities enrich our relationship with the Lord and with one another. They lay a firm foundation for ministry today which can be built upon for future ministry. We teach our children missions today that they might be our missionaries tomorrow. We teach music and worship that we might raise up a generation of worshipers who are also equipped to lead others in worship. We humble ourselves in prayer because God alone can mend broken lives. We invest in Bible study because God's Word equips us for every good work.

On top of all of these benefits, we find our lives enriched by the friendships that grow out of the Christian fellowship on Wednesday nights. Mingled all through the activities are conversations, encouragements, and laughter. God's people strengthen one another.

Whether you can come for all of the activities on Wednesday evenings or take part in only a few, make this night a priority for your family. You will find yourself enriched now and for years to come.

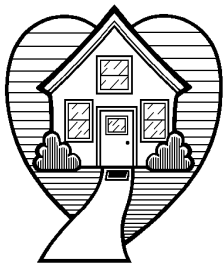

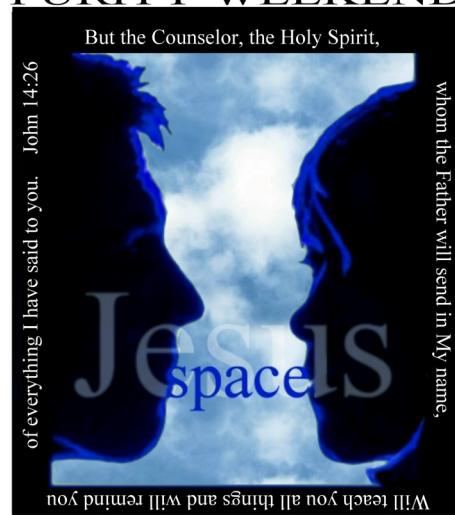
