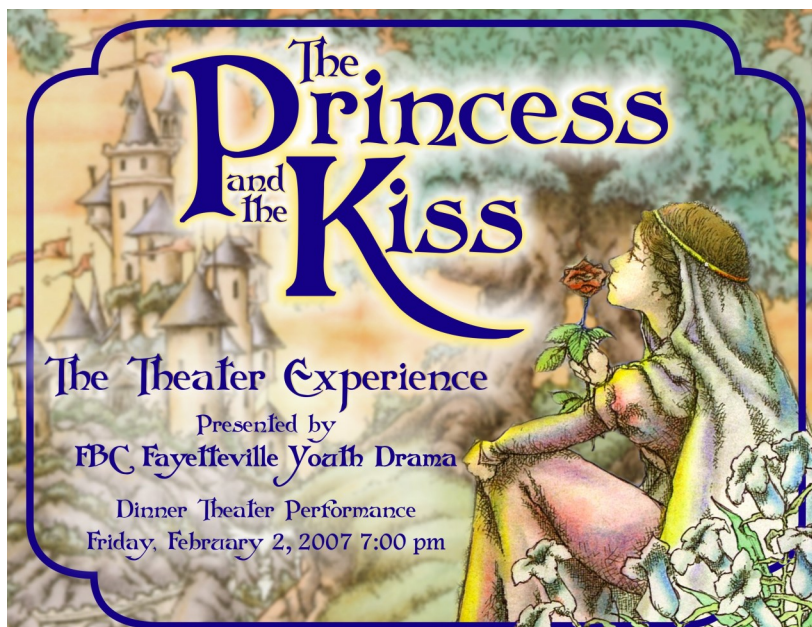

Next Level Leadership Conferences Report

Next Level Leadership Conferences were held at the Grand Ave. Baptist Church in Ft. Smith Jan.12-13. While winter storms almost caused a problem, the Lord held off the ice and snow and we were able to have this event. This was the 2nd annual event. Last year we had 58 in Eureka, and this year we had 218 attend the two conferences. Our church and collegiate ministry were one of the major sponsors of the event and we had over 60 attend from our BCM and FBCF college ministries.

Our own Steve Moore taught Leadership Greatness for Adults, and there was also a conference just for college students. We had two conference groups in Building Powerful Ministry Teams, and both conferences were designed to help us call out the called and to train and develop leaders.

Here are a few comments from participants:

♦ *I really enjoyed the mixture of lecture and activities. I also really enjoyed the fact that students led some of the student-oriented*

sessions since they are actively involved in a ministry at the same time.

- ♦ *Willingness to learn is necessary to lead.*
- ♦ *When you work together as a team, your job is to make your strengths prevalent and your weaknesses irrelevant.*
- ♦ *As a Next Level Leadership facilitator, I have personally observed just how effective this leadership training is with university students, pastors, seminary students, and lay leaders of all sizes of groups and churches. From our country to Kenya to Brazil and from small churches to mega churches and from small campus ministry groups to large ones, I have observed the transformation in leadership in all of these places and groups. It truly helps people and churches reach the next level.*

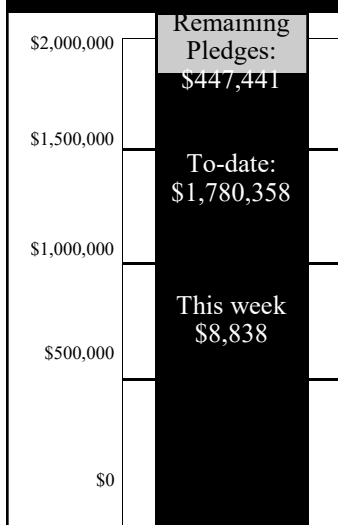

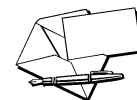
