

Next Level Leadership Conferences were held at the Grand Ave. Baptist Church in Ft. Smith Jan.12-13. While winter storms almost caused a problem, the Lord held off the ice and snow and we were able to have this event. This was the 2nd annual event. Last year we had 58 in Eureka, and this year we had 218 attend the two conferences. Our church and collegiate ministry were one of the major sponsors of the event and we had over 60 attend from our BCM and FBCF college ministries.



From our country to Kenya to Brazil and from small churches to mega churches and from small campus ministry groups to large have observed the transformation in leadership in all of these places and groups. It truly helps people and churches reach the next level.






