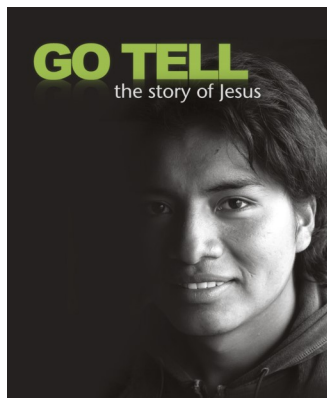

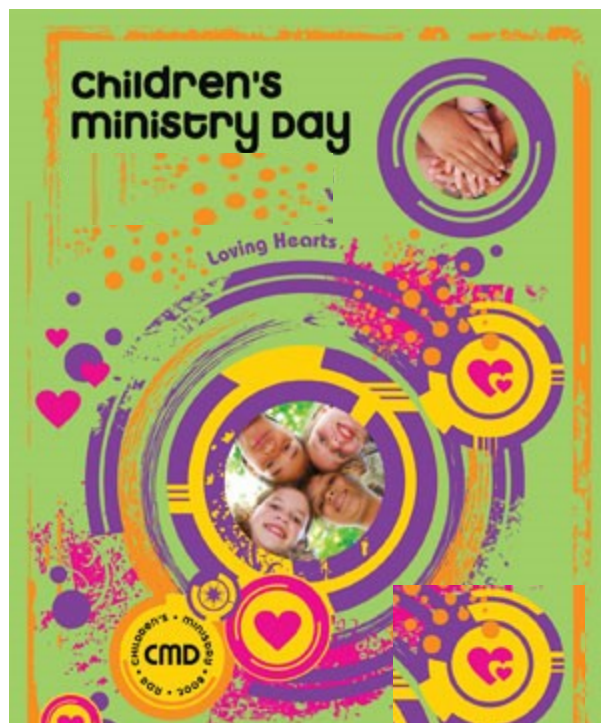

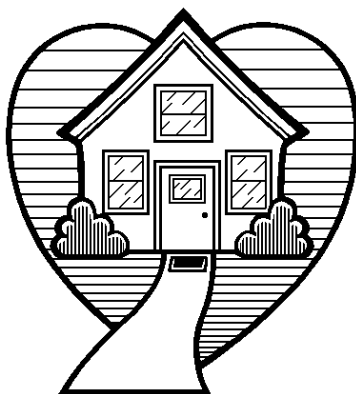


Food Pantry Day Sunday, February 1

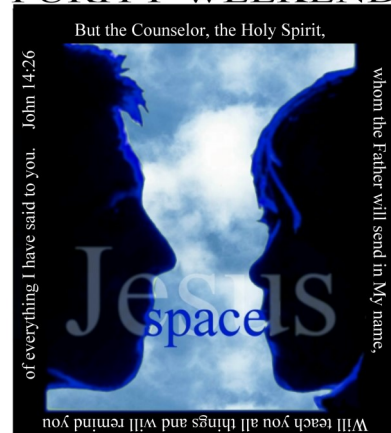

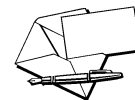
