I also have the opportunity to work with the children at the Tommy Jones Memorial Home located in West Fork. This is our (yours and ours) Northwest Arkansas emergency shelter for children.

I would like to thank you for your generous giving through the year to our ministry, specifically to the "Tommy House". I have noticed that your church has voluntarily given to the children at the "Tommy House" each month. I would like to make sure that you are aware that the gifts which you give are being used for quality support and comfort of the children at the home.

Over the past several months we have used your donations to purchase needed items for the children. These needed items include a *baby bed, changing table, cradle, highchair, winter jackets, gloves, and hats, tennis shoes, toys for the home, birthday gifts, luggage, and to pay for extracurricular activities at school.*

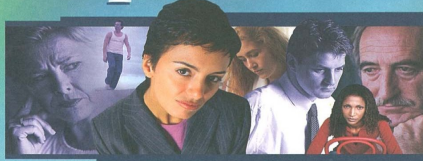

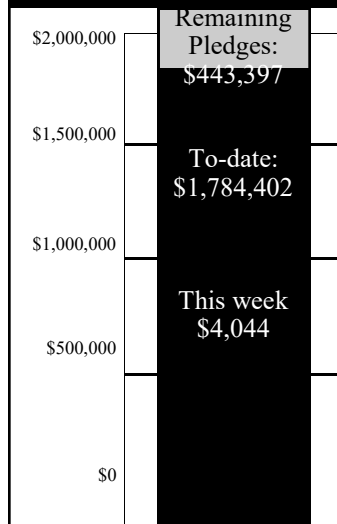
