PASTOR

And you will be My witnesses.
Acts 1:8

Today (Monday), the entire pastoral staff is leaving to attend the Arkansas Baptist State Evangelism Conference at Park Hill Baptist Church in Little Rock. For the past few years we have made attending this conference a priority. We use it as our staff retreat and as a time to focus our attention on evangelism.

Evangelism must continually be emphasized. All of us become involved in our day-to-day responsibilities and routines, working hard to accomplish whatever tasks come our way. But evangelism, by its very nature, pushes us outside of ourselves to consider the most basic need of another person. Opportunities to witness are often unplanned. In fact, the open door to share our faith may come when we are involved in something else important. It is during these times that we need to be aware of our primary calling to be witnesses.

Evangelism skills must continually be sharpened. Like any task which we do, we look for ways to improve and adjust to be more effective. A method that may be effective in witnessing to one person from a specific background may not be effective for a different person. Growing in our skills of evangelism makes us willing to see the needs of the person receiving our witness of Christ.

A focus on evangelism reminds us that the work of the evangelist is one that is dependent on Christ. He is the one who empowers us to be a witness. He is the one who draws lost men and women to Himself. He is the one who works in new believers to mature them in the faith. Effective witnesses depend on Christ above all.

As your church staff prioritizes evangelism, I encourage you to do the same. Consider how you can be involved in being a witness, how your skills can be sharpened, and how you can trust Christ to work through you.
