## Washington Elementary Adoption

Our church has an amazing ministry opportunity to minister to our community on an ongoing basis. We will be adopting Washington Elementary school to provide support for the school & their families. The school has around 370 students with 45 teachers/staff. They have 22 children that are considered "Families in Transition" and 40 families that are in need of help. Giving time to students is one of their greatest needs. God has blessed our church so richly and we want be a blessing to others in our community.

#### Ways you can help -

- **Supplies** We will have an ongoing list of supplies that we will collect for the school.
- Lunch Pack Program This is a program where kids who have little or no food receive food in their backpack on Fridays. We will need 3-4 volunteers on Fridays to sort & package the food and take it to the school.
- Center Time Buddies Volunteers will be needed one hour a week to go into the classroom to help children one on one during their center time.
- Lunch Buddies Volunteers to go have lunch with children who don't have parents or whose parents can't come, especially on special occasion days.
- After School Event Buddies Volunteers to occasionally go and pick up children and take them to special school events – Fall Carnival, music programs, etc.
- ◆ Teacher Appreciation We will do projects to show support for the teachers.

These are a few of the opportunities that we will be able to help the school with this year. You can sign up to volunteer for any of these projects by signing up at the Information Center or by contacting Lisa Wheat. We will also have a box to begin collecting supplies outside the Preschool area beginning February 1.




