A person who has not received Christ will have a reminder of how God loves him and how he can trust Jesus as Savior and Lord. A person who is already a Christian will have an excellent tool to use as she tells a friend about Jesus.

Easter is only six weeks away. FIRST Touch teams begin in four weeks. Our 40-day devotional reading begins in two weeks. Will you begin today praying for revival and preparing your heart for what God can do in and through you?




