Later this morning (Tuesday) I will be attending the funeral of a neighbor. He served the Lord as a minister of the gospel for over forty-five years. Many years ago this neighbor heard the message of truth, believed, and was sealed by the Holy Spirit. Because he accepted Jesus as his Savior and Lord, he lived his life for God and will spend eternity in His presence in Heaven.

Later this week another church member will be preaching a funeral message for a relative. The relative had heard the message of truth many times, but did not receive the gift of salvation, did not believe in Jesus, and was not sealed by the Holy Spirit. Because he did not accept Jesus as Savior and Lord, he lived his life for himself and will spend eternity separated from the presence of God in Hell.

Two men – two good men – who made very different choices in this life and will experience very different existences in eternity. Which funeral service would you rather attend? Which testimony would you rather hear? Even more important, which testimony could be said of you?

There are people who are members of a local church (even First Baptist Church), who are active members, who can tell you when they joined the church or when they were baptized, who cannot say with certainty that they listened to the message of truth **and believed it and were sealed in Jesus with the Holy Spirit**. They are good people – religious people – who have made a choice in this life to be good and religious, but have resisted trusting Jesus.

Today, tell someone in your family when you believed in Jesus and accepted Him as your Savior and Lord. When you see me in church, stop me and tell me when you believed in Jesus. If you are a Sunday School director or teacher, tell your class when you believed in Jesus.

Perhaps you can tell when you joined the church or when you were baptized, but you cannot say with certainty that you believed the message of truth and were sealed in Jesus with the Holy Spirit. Today, bow your heart to the Lord and receive Jesus as your Savior and Lord. Repent of your sin and give your heart to Jesus. Then call me on the phone and tell me. Tell your family. Tell your friends. It is the most important message you will share.

Let us make it our practice to be witnesses of these things.

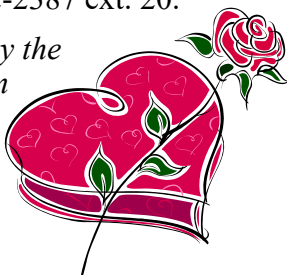

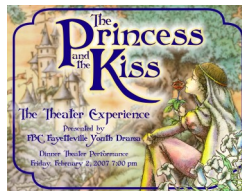
