First Baptist Church consistently demonstrates a passion to take the gospel to those who need to hear about Jesus. This is evident in our partnerships with Ekaterinburg (Russia), "Judah" (SE Asia), Metro Church (Bentonville) as well as our working relationships with other ministries like Grace Chinese Christian Church, Arkansas Baptist Children's Homes, and Baptist Collegiate Ministry. We are committed to tell the good news!

As Easter approaches, we will be using every opportunity to take the good news to the people living near downtown Fayetteville. **"Celebrate Easter"** will be a focused effort by our church family to tell the families living around us about Jesus and to invite them to worship with us on Easter morning.

On **Saturday, March 13**, we will meet in Mitchell Hall at 9:30 a.m. to form teams for prayer-walking, prayer-watching, and prayerfully preparing packets to distribute. 6-8 teams will walk throughout the neighborhoods from North Street on the north, Mission/Fletcher on the east, College Ave. on the west, and MLK on the south. Our goal is to saturate the neighborhoods with prayer, asking God to call out witnesses (us!) into His harvest.

Another team will have members strategically placed throughout the neighborhoods, sitting and watching people travel up and down our streets, praying for the multitudes to be saved. These prayer warriors will be like the watchman on the wall, watching and praying.

A third team will be stationed at the church, preparing 1000 packets of evangelistic tracts, cups, evangelistic booklets, notepads, pens, and a letter from the pastor. This team will be praying for each family who will receive a gift packet from First Baptist Church.

On **Saturday, March 20**, we will again gather in Mitchell Hall at 9:30 a.m. to regroup our teams to distribute the gift packets. Our goal is to place these gifts on 1000 doors, letting our neighbors know about Jesus as we invite them to worship. These efforts will be followed-up by a postcard invitation, encouraging each family to join us for Easter morning.

On **Easter Sunday, April 4**, we will provide two morning worship services: 8:15 a.m. and 10:50 a.m. We will need additional people to work in greeting guests in the parking lot, at the doors, and in the sanctuary. Other folks will be needed to work in the preschool during the worship times.

Celebrate Easter will require a commitment from the entire church family to reach our neighbors with the gospel and to prepare a welcoming environment as they accept our invitation to worship. As we work together, Easter will be a great celebration!

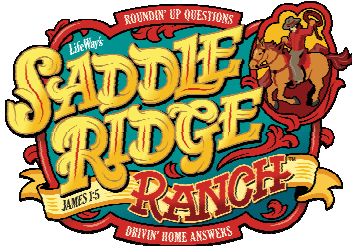

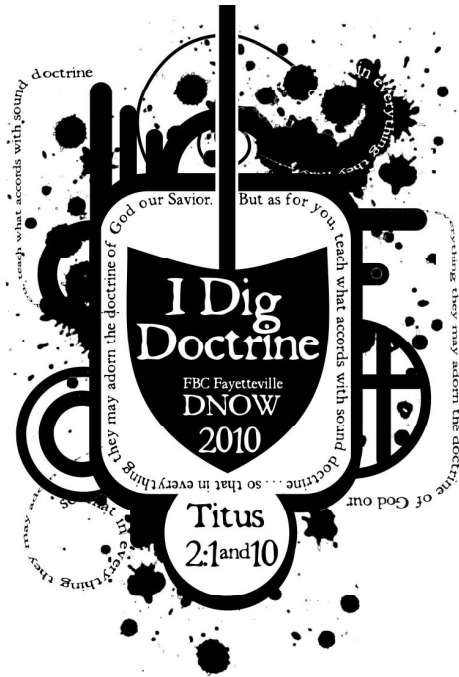

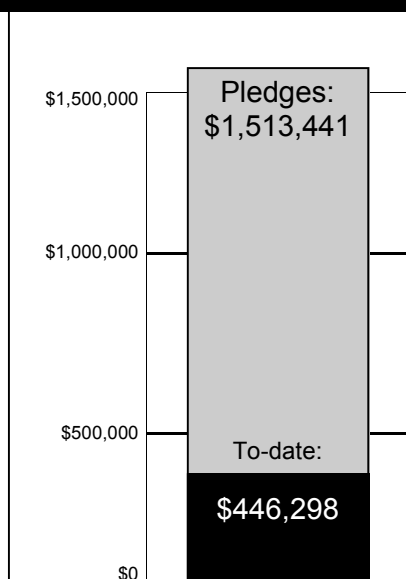
