LifeBoxes FOR OUR MILITARY

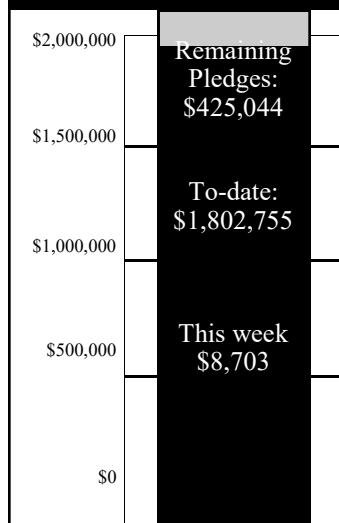
