It will be a fine day when we ordain three godly men as deacons on Sunday, March 29, during the evening worship service. David Savage, Dwayne Calhoun, and Emery Scism were nominated by individuals from our church family, questioned and recommended by our deacon body, and approved unanimously by the church body. All of

this has been done prayerfully, believing that each of them has been called by God to serve as deacons.

We are blessed to have these men joining with our other deacons to provide servant leadership for our church family. These called out men provide steady, wise leadership with a heart for God and a passion for God's bride.

From time to time I have been asked, "What do the deacons do?" That this question needs to be asked is a demonstration of the humble, servant's heart that these men possess. Our deacons teach Sunday School and Discipleship Training classes, serve as ushers and greeters, drive the church bus, wash dishes on Wednesday nights, sing in the choir, lead in prayer, visit hospitals and nursing homes, give generously, work on committees, encourage the struggling, clear out ice storm debris, serve on mission teams and so much more.

In a more formal sense, our deacons pray for the needs of our church family during their monthly meeting. If a crisis arises, the deacons provide wisdom to steady the church through the storm. Our deacons contact guests to the church and visit church members in the hospital, nursing homes, and facing times of loss. While not serving as a governing board, they keep abreast of the workings of the church. Our deacons help the church maintain theological clarity and moral integrity. Through their leadership, we continue to grow in our love for God (worship), our love for one another (fellowship), and our love for all people (evangelism and missions).

God has blessed First Baptist Church with a great deacon body. Come worship with us March 29 as these three men join these servant leaders.
